

## IEP PREPARATION TOOL FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

The Individual Education Plan (IEP) is an important document in BC schools that serves as a roadmap to student success. Individual Education Plans are a requirement under the [School Act](#), mandated by [Ministerial Order 638/95](#) which requires that:

- the IEP is reviewed **at least once** during the school year.
- parents **must be consulted** about the preparation of the IEP.

Parents/Guardians: Use and share this IEP preparation tool to contribute to your child's IEP with the school team.

### SCHOOL TEAMS PREPARE FOR STUDENT IEP'S IN MANY WAYS:

- Observing your child in class
- Talking to your child about their student profile and/or aspirations
- Reviewing historical information (previous assessments or report cards, last year's IEP)
- Completing academic testing
- Completing behavioural checklists
